- D. A record of your **SAT** and/or **ACT** scores and scores from any subject tests you may have taken.
- E. A current yearbook photo or similar style photo of yourself.
- F. Handwritten applications will **NOT** be accepted.
- G. **Applications must be received by April 1 of the year for which you are applying.**
